Fall Clean Sweep Cancelled

Due to the City's being out of dumpsters due to limited funding, our Clean Sweep scheduled for October 21st had to be cancelled. The cost of a full priced dumpster is prohibitive. However, the City will conduct a Fall Leaf & Brush collection for our neighborhood the week of November 20. What follows is a list of rules for this event.



- Paper lawn sacks only (NO plastic bags).
- Only masking tape may be used to seal bags.
- Brush must be bundled, not exceeding 4 feet in length & 2 feet in diameter.
- Use twine for bundles, NO wire.
- Sacks & bundles must weigh no more than 40 lbs. each.
- No more than 20 sacks/bundles per residence.
- NO grass clippings - NO trash.
- If wet weather is forecast, cover sacks/bundles with plastic.

Residents may use the City's two drop-off sites, which are open every Saturday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. through January 15, 2007. The sites are at 4707 Deramus Ave. and south of Interstate 470 on Raytown Rd. For more information, call the 3-1-1 Action Center at 816-513-1313 or dial 3-1-1.
