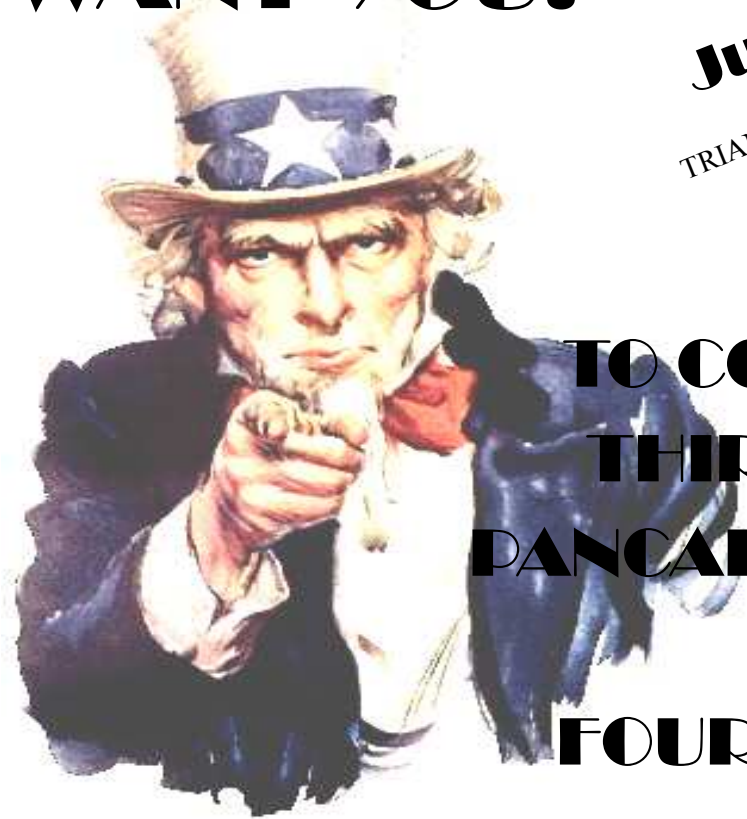

CRIME REPORT...GOOD NEWS!

There have been two major arrests involving the burglary problem in KC Metro Patrol and Kansas, between 55th & 85th Streets west of Wornall Rd. Two felons have been arrested and charged and were most likely responsible for over 100 burglaries and other crimes. Substantial recovery was made of stolen property.

There should be a noticeable drop in burglaries in the area, but don't drop your guard. You have been doing a great job of looking out for your neighbors and neighborhood. There are still offenders out there, so keep up the good work.

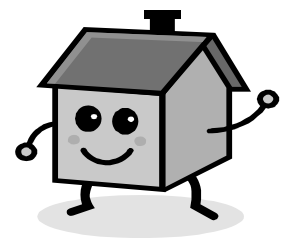
All of this was done with volunteer labor, donated funds and hard work.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

On the small island at Brookside Blvd. and Huntington stands a metal sculpture entitled "The Birds". It was the creation of a sculptor named Jack Bowen, and the WHHA Board of Directors purchased it in 1944 for \$1400. The City put in the concrete base for the sculpture.

Alas, "The Birds" at some point in the past has lost the entire right wing, which is most apparent if one looks at it directly from the east. It seems to be worn or damaged slightly in other places. Also, sadly but appropriately, its hollow body is now the nesting place for some small sparrows.

The Board has discussed replacing it but some WHHA residents have argued that the sculpture is too significant and so it should be saved and repaired. In order to make an informed decision, the Board has decided to ask all residents their choice and suggestions, and that question is on the Questionnaire included in this June Newsletter. Please let us know, through the Questionnaire, your opinion of what action we should take on "The Birds".


In May WHHA representatives took to the streets for the spring Home Inspection. Thank you to all home owners who are doing what they can to keep our neighborhood looking good.
